 - It is a software package from Clarivate Analysis (previously Thomson Reuters) and help you to write your scholarly articles
 - EndNote is a reference and figure database
 - EndNote is a bibliography and manuscript maker
 - EndNote is an online search tool

About EndNote

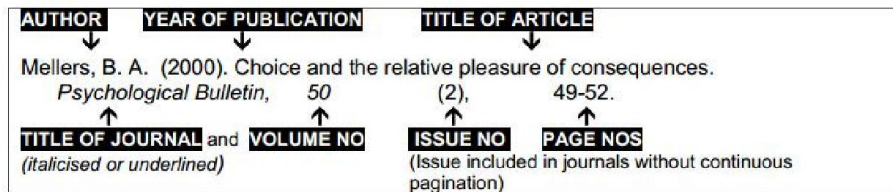
- *Why we use Endnote?*
 - Create an online account to search, save and use your research sources

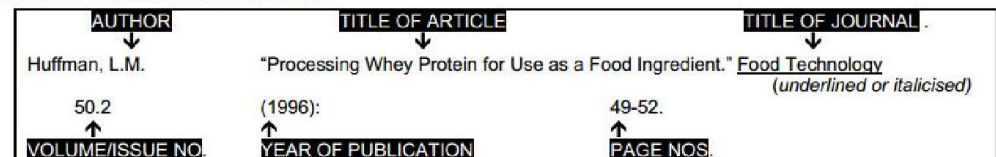

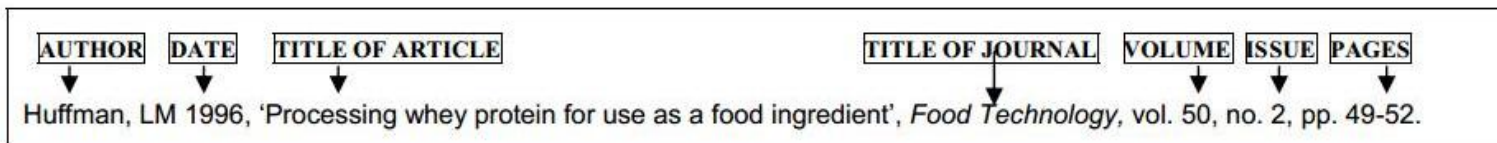



Rules for manual entry

- ***Author:***
 - Last name, first name (Calvert, Philip or Calvert, P)
 - Calvert, P (P will be considered as first name)
 - Direct Name (Philip Calvert)
 - Each author on his/her own line
 - Corporate authors need a comma at the end
 - World Health Organization, Geneva

Rules for manual entry

- ***Title***
 - Don't put punctuation at the end
 - Don't italicize
 - NOTE: Endnote will not change capitalization
- ***General***
 - Don't put extra information (eds., vol., page)
 - Change things to see its output!
- ***Keywords***
 - Use Line breaks, semicolon or back slash as separator
 - Don't use comma

The jump was due to growing demand for its garments from Western buyers and the recent initiatives aimed at making the country's apparel factories safer, according to a survey.
